Students Develop Across All Disciplines

At Ariel, the Othellos are led by our Artistic Directors, **Nicci Hopson** and **Bev Locke**, supported by a dedicated team of skilled Tutors, Support Tutors and pastoral/administrative staff. Many have been part of Ariel for years, bringing a wealth of experience, creativity and passion for the arts. Together, they know the academy inside out and are committed to nurturing every student's unique talents.

Our curriculum provides a well-rounded performing arts education, ensuring students thrive across all disciplines:

Technical Skills

- Acting: voice projection, movement, characterisation, improvisation and creative writing.
- Singing: breath control, diction, expression, tone colour and intonation, with a focus on acting through song.
- Dance: rhythm, coordination, flexibility, posture and musicality across a variety of dance styles.

A Week at Othellos

Combining acting, singing and dance equips students with core theatrical skills and essential life skills, including teamwork, resilience and creativity. These disciplines bring mental and emotional benefits, build confidence, improve communication and foster self-expression, giving students pride in their achievements.

Transferable Life Skills

Beyond the stage, Ariel students develop skills that extend into every area of life. collaboration, discipline, problem-solving and adaptability learned through performing arts are invaluable in education, work and personal relationships. By setting goals, overcoming challenges and celebrating successes, students gain a strong sense of confidence and pride that supports lifelong growth and achievement.

Musical Theatre

Bringing together singing, acting and dance to create versatile performers who can combine these disciplines into one dynamic art form.

Showcase Preparation

Students work towards Ariel's annual showcase, performed in a professional theatre. This highlight of the year gives every student the opportunity to perform on a large stage in front of an audience.

Throughout the year, students thrive in a supportive, inclusive and creative environment, where every individual is encouraged to shine. At Ariel, we don't just teach performing arts—we inspire confidence, creativity and a lifelong love of performance.


